Professor Giorgio Scagliotti welcomes the participants and immediately starts the meeting that was lead by prof. Magnani. It was a quick update of the status of works and to see if critical issues occurred and have to be addressed immediately.

First of all, a summary of the efforts done in the past month was given by prof. Magnani: he worked on statistical analyses on the WP6, WP7 and WP4 survey. He is still waiting for feedback from dr. Planchard on what he prepared.

He also prepared a new short survey (uploaded on the website: <http://www.euprojectmine.eu/index.php/survey-4>) to be addressed to clinical centres who replied to the general survey managed by WP4 in order to investigate their interaction with Cancer Registries.

He also contacted Dean Fennel of IMIG to access their database but he didn't received any reply so far so he will ask to dr. Marianne Nicolson to follow-up on this.

Prof. Magnani also prepared some slides on health surveillance and asbestos related risks that would need some feedback from partners and then need to be translated into the various national languages by partners. These can be used as a starting point for the educational event.

The discussion moved then to the next educational event to prepare. One option could be to organize a live meeting, open also for advocacy groups, to be recorded and broadcasted via web. The best thing could be to organize it in Torino so to minimize costs. All partners should be present and it could be organized at the end of April/beginning of May.

Silvia Mattone will organize a doodle in order to find a possible common date. During the next Management Board Meeting in Milan on 8th of March details will be discussed.
